Dear Parent/Carer

Lancaster House is organising an ice-skating trip to Clarks Village in Street. The trip will firstly be open to Lancaster House members and to other Houses if places are not filled, at a later date.

The trip is on <u>Tuesday 10th December</u>. We will meet at 15:35 at Bridgewater and Taunton College lay-by and depart at 15.45. We will travel to Clarks Village by coach. We are booked to skate at 18.00 so students will have enough time to get changed before the session. The skating session finishes at 18.45. There will be a chance to eat and shop before the session. Students may decide to buy something to eat or bring a packed meal if they prefer.

We shall be arriving back around 20.00pm at the BTC lay-by where students should be collected from. In case of any delays or changes to the timings, we will ask students to contact parents on route.

All students will be expected to skate and will not be allowed to shop whilst others are skating. All students will have to be in a group of 3 and no more than 6. Years 7 will be accompanied by a member of staff during their shopping time. Students need to bring a pair of thick long socks and gloves for skating. The rink is undercover, but students must ensure they have appropriate clothes to keep them warm and dry.

The price of the trip will be £18.00. As there are only 60 places available, these will be allocated on first come first served basis and a reserve list will be drawn up for those who failed to get on. The cost includes transport, ice skating and the hire of ice skates. Students will have to bring their own money if they wish to do some Christmas shopping.
